Wedding veils, if not passed down through the family, might also be used in another form, particularly as christening robes during the early twentieth century. The trend for producing costume dramas for stage and screen (e.g., *Sense and*

*Sensibility* directed by Ang Lee, 1995) has seen the recreation of a number of period styles, and these in turn have influenced today's designers.
